## ORDER

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court on the Joint Emergency Request for Bond. On November 19, 2010, the Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit ordered that the defendant be released subject to conditions set by this Court. Upon review and consideration, it is

## ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- 1. Said motion for bond is **GRANTED**. The defendant shall be released immediately from the custody of the Bureau of Prisons on his personal recognizance, subject to the standard conditions of bond and the following conditions and provisions required under the Bail Reform Act:
  - (1) Upon release from the Bureau of Prisons, the defendant shall immediately contact the Pretrial Services Office. The defendant shall appear at all proceedings as required and shall surrender for service of any sentence imposed as directed. The defendant shall next appear as directed upon notice.
  - (2) The defendant shall not commit any offense in violation of federal, state or local law while on release in this case.
  - (3) Abide by the following restrictions on personal association, place of abode, or travel: Defendant is restricted in residence and travel to the Southern District of Florida.

- (4) Refrain from possessing a firearm, destructive device, or other dangerous weapon.
- (5) Refrain from excessive use of alcohol.
- (6) Refrain from any use or possession of a narcotic drug or other controlled substances in 21 U.S.C. § 802, unless with prior written approval of the Pretrial Services Officer or as may be lawfully prescribed in writing by a licensed medical practitioner.
- (7) Report as soon as possible to the Pretrial Services Office anycontact with law enforcement personnel, including, but not limited to, any arrest, questioning, or traffic stop.
- 2. The defendant shall appear at a bond hearing on November 23, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. before the Duty magistrate judge at the United States District Court located at 301 North Miami Avenue, Miami Florida 33128 to determine further conditions of release including whether a bond should be required.
